

Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI)

Through *Pacific Women*, the Australian Government will spend approximately AU\$3.9 million over ten years (2012-2022) on initiatives supporting gender equality and women's empowerment in RMI. Approximately AU\$440,000 has been spent delivering activities in-country (FY2012-2013 to FY2015-2016).
